The ES Skylight is 53% more efficient than the new 2010 ENERGY STAR criteria!

Higher efficiency directly equates to lower heating costs, a savings that is collected year after year.

High Visible Light AND Clear Glass

The industry trend towards advances in thermal insulation results in an opaque glazing solution. We did not follow that trend. The new ES Skylight not only retains a high visible light transmittance (VT) of 0.49, but also retains a see through view outwards – like clear glass.

Sound Transmittance (STC)

In addition to saving energy, the ES Skylight's advanced design provides exceptional sound transmittance control (STC) as well. This is often a goal for homes and businesses near freeways and airports.

Utility Provider Rebates

Snow Load Requirements

The ES Skylight can be installed in mountainous regions which require extreme high snow loads for building / remodeling. In such cold climates the energy savings, provided by the ES Skylight's exceptional insulating values, will be even greater.

90° Curb to Roof Pitch REQUIRED

Minimum 2/12 pitch is required for all glass skylights.

NOTE:

CrystaLite will add 1/2" to Outside Curb Dimensions which allows for 1/4" clearance all around.

CrystaLite will deduct 1/2" to Daylight Opening Dimensions which allows for 1/4" clearance all around.
